The force of resistance which this table seems to oppose to shear and to traction gives it a singular energy. Krack table in stainless steel, KARIM RASHID FOR RILUC.



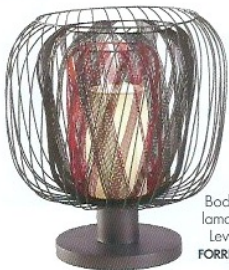
